The resulting **Chocolate Caramel Porter** which blends dark malts with 150 pounds of organic salted caramel sauce and 50 pound of cocoa husks with a touch of lactose sugar rounds out the sweet flavors to create a full body porter with a beautifully creamy mouth feel (6% ABV).

**\$2 per pint will be donated to benefit Friends of Connect Buncombe** which supports the implementation of the City and County Greenway and Trail Plans to develop a system of connected pedestrian and bike pathways for public use.

Speaking at the event will be Adam Charnack, owner of Hi-Wire Brewing. So come on out to Hi-Wire's south slope location at 197 Hilliard Avenue and enjoy yourself. The event is open to the public and is not a ticketed event.

Come on by. Drink beer for a cause that directly impacts our city and its growth while learning about Friends of Connect Buncombe and finding out more about the beer directly from the brewers.
